

PREPARATION OF STATEMENT OF INTENTION

In no more than five double spaced typed pages:

- A. Explain why you intend to study law, and why you selected Cal Northern School of Law.
- B. Describe the particular contribution you expect to make as an attorney and describe the personal attributes that qualify you for the task.
- C. Discuss the adjustments that will be necessary in your life due to attending a night law school, and how you expect to cope with this challenge.
- D. Describe what you believe the study of law might be like.
- E. Explain what financial hardships will be imposed on you by law school attendance and how you intend to cope with any hardship.
- F. Describe how many hours in a week you are prepared to devote to studying law (excluding classroom time) and what your study schedule might be like.
- G. Describe how your family (if married) feels about you attending law school and what support you expect from them.

This statement is a critical part of your application for admission. Please write it yourself. Your ability to express yourself in writing clearly and concisely will be carefully discussed with you at the oral review.

This statement must be typed; handwritten statements will not be accepted.
